

**CIRCULAR**

Sub : Compulsory information to District Surveillance Officer on discharge of COVID positive patients / suspects from institutions.

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It has come to the notice of the undersigned that the Medical Superintendents/ Administrative Medical Officers / In-charge Officers of COVID facilities are discharging the patients or the COVID suspects (after the test result comes out negative and as per protocol) without informing the District Surveillance Officer and this is resulting in losing the track of patients / persons for subsequent field visits. Therefore, it is instructed that all Medical Superintendents / Administrative Medical Officers / In-charge Officers should inform respective District Surveillance Officers on such discharges.
