NOTIFICATION

In order to control the spread of COVID-19, the Government of Karnataka in exercise of powers conferred under section 4, 15 and 17 of the Karnataka Epidemic Disease Ordinance, 2020 (KARNATAKA Ordinance 7 of 2020) had issued several notifications to safeguard the interest of general public and also to confer certain powers to other authorities for strict enforcement of the Ordinance. Since, these notifications were valid for a period of one year from the date of issue and the validity will expire on 2nd May, 2021 and subsequent dates in June 2020. Therefore, in order to continue the force of these notifications it is necessary and essential to extend the validity of the notifications under the Karnataka Epidemic Disease Act, 2020 to comeback the spread of COVID-19. Hence the following notification is issued.

ORDER

In exercise of the powers conferred under Section, 4, 15 and 17 of the Karnataka Epidemic Disease Act, 2020 (KARNATAKA Act 26 of 2020), the Government of Karnataka hereby extends all the notifications, issued earlier pursuant to Sec 4, 15 and 17 of Karnataka Epidemic Disease Ordinance 2020 vide notifications dated: 02.05.2020, 22.05.2020, 05.06.2020, 06.06.2020, 16.06.2020 for a further period of one year from the respective date of completion of one year or till it is withdrawn whichever is earlier.
