"Till date 598 COVID-19 positive cases have been confirmed. This includes 25 deaths & 255 discharges" +1 death due to Non – Covid Cause. 09 new positive cases have been reported from 01st May 2020, 5:00 PM to 02nd May 2020, 12:00 noon.

P-590, 82 years Male residents of Bidar admitted on 27.04.2020 evening with complaint of SARI died on 28.04.2020 at designated hospital Bidar, found positive for Covid-19.

P-557, 63 years Male resident of Bangalore Urban with diabetes, hyper tension, hypothyroidism and renal failure was on dialysis, multiple myeloma on chemotherapy admitted with complaint of breathlessness on 30.04.2020 died on 02.05.2020 due to cardiac arrest at designated hospital Bangalore Urban.
