NOVEL CORONA VIRUS (COVID-19)

MEDIA BULLETIN

DATED: 03/05/2020 Evening Report

World Health Organization has declared the recent Novel Corona Virus, COVID-19 as **Public Health Emergency of International Concern (PHEIC)** which has affected **215 Countries / Territories including** India till date. WHO has characterized COVID-19 as a **Pandemic** on 11th March 2020.

In this context, Karnataka State has strengthened all Surveillance and containment measures against the possible spread of disease.

"As of 5:00 PM of 03rd May 2020, cumulatively 614 COVID-19 Positive cases have been confirmed in the State, it includes 25 Deaths & 293 Discharges" +1 death due to non – Covid Cause.

Out of remaining **295** cases, **292** COVID-19 positive patients are in isolation at designated hospitals are stable and **03 in ICU** (P-101, P-349 & P-536).

13 new cases have been confirmed for COVID-19 in the state *from 02.05.2020, 5:00 PM to 03.05.2020, 5:00 PM*.

Programmatic Updates

1	In view of decision taken by Government to continue the lockdown up to 17th May 2020. Director General of Civil Aviation, GOI has issued circular on "Prohibiting domestic passenger flight operations for further extended period up to 23:59 hrs IST on 17th May 2020 and this restriction shall not apply to International all-cargo operations and flights specially approved by DGCA". (Ref. No. 4/1/2020-IR Dated: 02.05.2020)
2	Chief Secretary to the Government of Karnataka, has issued Circular, that 100% staff (Group A, B, C and D) from all the offices of the Departments mentioned as an essential services in the circular even number dated on 18.04.2020 should report to the duty from 04.05.2020 to 17.05.2020, in the three Red Districts of Bengaluru Urban, Bengaluru Rural and Mysore Districts, all Group A & B officers and 33% of all Group C & D staff in respect of other departments in red zone districts. 100% staff (Group A, B, C and D) of all offices in all other Orange and Green Zones Districts, should report to duty from 04.05.2020. (Ref. No. ಸಿ.ಆ.ಸು.ಇ 123 ಡಿಬಿಎಂ (ಭಾಗ). Dated: 02.05.2020).
3	Commissioner, Health & Family Welfare services, has issued Orders for provision on category B (asymptomatic but suffering from co-morbid conditions) and C (asymptomatic and healthy) International passengers can be given the choice of staying in star hotels (COVID-19 Quarantine) at their own cost. *All protocols and requirements of institutional quarantine should be followed at these hotels. (Ref. No. DD/SSU/Novel Corona virus/17/2019-20 Dated: 02.05.2020)
4	In continuation to the Government Permission for "movement of migrant workers, pilgrims, tourists, students, and other persons who are stranded, as one time measure". The Commissioner, Health & Family welfare services has issued orders to the Districts to ensure the compulsory health screening of the pass holders/ travellers in the receiving Districts. Cases should be shifted to dedicated COVID hospitals or Quarantine Units as per the screening and lab testing reports accordingly. (Ref. No. HFW/COM/PS/20-21 Dated: 02.05.2020)
5	In continuation to the Government order No. RD 158 2020 Dated. 02.05.2020, Chief Secretary, government of Karnataka. Has issued orders on "Inter-District movement of Individuals and Vehicles, with appropriate approvals from respective Deputy Commissioners of Districts / Deputy Commissioner of Police in Commission rates. (Ref. No. RD 158 TNR 2020 Dated.03.05.2020)
6	In continuation to the orders from Ministry of Health and family Welfare, Gol D.O No.Z.28015/192020 Dtd.30.04.2020 on extension of lockdown period from 04.05.2020 to 17.05.2020, Chief Secretary, Government of Karnataka has declared the Districts under Red, Orange and Yellow Districts. (Ref. No. ಕಂಇ158 ಟಿ.ಎನ್.ಆರ್ 2020 Dated:03.05.20210)
7	ICMR-Ministry of Health Research GOI has approved KIMS-Hubli hospital and research centre for conducting the Clinical trials for Convalescent Plasma Therapy for COVID-19.
8	 On 02.05.2020: In 31 Fever Clinics of BBMP, in total 126 people have been screened and till on date 6316 people have been screened. In 527 Fever Clinics of State, in total 13533 people have been screened and till on date 198442 people have been screened.

	 In 100 Fever Clinics of Private Hospital and Colleges were operationalized, in Total 1431 people have been screened and till on date 12946 people have been screened. 					
9	Home Quarantine Enforcement Squad have quarantined 16 persons in Institutions on 02.05.2020 based on the complaints received from public & totally till date 872 have been shifted from home Quarantine to institutional quarantine.					
10	The positive cases and suspects hospitalized in the designated hospitals and quarantined persons will be staying there for a minimum period of 14 days or till the successive samples of the positive case are proved negative or as per the treating physicians advice. This long duration of stay in isolation requires a mental booster for keeping oneself calm & quite. Foreseeing this Department has arranged for Mental Health Counseling of such patients and contacts 1989 sessions were held on 02.05.2020 and so far 62244 number of counseling sessions have been held counseling sessions for migrants.					
11	In view to spread Awareness and Effective Communication on COVID-19, Govt. of India, Ministry of Health and Family Welfare has lunched "Aarogya Setu" Mobile app on 09.04.2020. Application can downloaded from Google Play store and App store (Apple).
