NOTIFICATION

World Health Organization has declared the recent Novel Corona Virus, COVID-19 as Public Health Emergency of International Concern (PHEIC) which has affected 213 Countries / Territories including India till date. WHO has characterized COVID-19 as a Pandemic on 11th March 2020.

In this context, Karnataka State has strengthened all Surveillance and containment measures against the possible spread of disease. The number of Covid-19 cases has been on the rise due to opening of economy & movement of people across districts & States. Bengaluru city (BBMP & Surrounding) which is the economic hub of the state has seen large number of travellers and returnees. Surrounding districts also depend on Bengaluru for medical facilities.

There are three kinds of facilities planned for managing COVID-19 patients. These are Covid Care Centre (CCC) – meant for managing asymptomatic persons, dedicated Covid Health Centre (DCHC) – meant for managing mild to moderate symptomatic persons and dedicated Covid Hospitals (DCH) – meant for managing serious patients.

There is a need to increase the number of COVID-19 beds for managing COVID 19 positive patients. Therefore, in exercise of powers conferred u/s 2 and 3 of Epidemic Act 1897, the following Medical College and Speciality hospitals are designated to function as Covid 19 treatment facilities with immediate effect until further orders.

These medical facilities should also run fever clinics (atleast 2 per college) and ensure that ICMR approved COVID-19 testing laboratories are established. They will make necessary arrangements for receiving patients, triaging, investigations & their treatment immediately as per the treatment Protocols issued by the Government from time to time. The Medical Superintendents /Nodal persons should work in co-ordination with the Nodal Officers appointed by Health & Family Welfare Department /BBMP and Medical education. The package rates for treatment will be as notified by the Government. Necessary steps to be taken to ensure that no COVID-19 patients are denied admission / treatment.
