SPECIAL INSTRUCTIONS REGARDING RAMDAN FAST AND TARAWIH DURING THE LOCKDOWN

Since the blessed month of Ramdan is beginning during the lockdown period, the below instructions

## should be strictly followed:

- Do not miss the fast unless there is a valid reason.
- 2. As usual, five-time prayers with jamaat shuld be observed at home. Please do not visit the masjid.
- 3. Similarly, all the family members should also pray Tarawih at home with Jamaat.
- Never invite people living near your house for Tarawih at home with Jamaat.
- Strictly avoid roaming outside during the days and nights of Ramadan.
- 6. During the lockdown, do not make arrangements to awaken people for Sehri by using the loudspeaker.
- 7. Follow the istructions of the government with regards to buying and selling of goods.
- Completing of the Quran in 6 days of 10 days during Tarawih at home or a Musalla should not be or organized.
- Muazin or Imam of the Masjid cam make announcement regarding the end of Sehri and beginning of Iftar as usally made during the month of Ramdazan.
- 10. Any kind of Sehri of Iftar parties should be completely avoided.
- 11. During the days of Ramzan, remember to help the poor and deedy, Spend your Zakat and Sadaqah to help your relatives and neighbours. Also help your non - Muslim neighbours who are in need.
- 12. In the holy month of Ramadan, especially during the blessed hours of Iftar and Tahajud, special Duas Should be made for the well-being of our country and the entire humanity, and for the liberation from this difficult situation.
- 13. Parents, guardians and responsible members should stop their children and people under their influence from any activity that can harm the intrest of our country and our community.
- 14. Youths are specially advised to not roam aroung in two-wheelers of four-wheelers during night time and not to do wheeling. It is strictly prohibited to go outside; any violation of law will result in
  strict action from the police.

## Special Request:

- A. Madrasas are an asset of our Deen and community, it is our duty to safeguard and continue them. Therefore, please continue your contributions to the Madrasa as usual and try to deliver it by yourself.
- B. Responsible members of the Masjid ans Madrasa are request to take good care of the imam, muazin, teachers and support staff, Please do not make any reduction in their salaries.
- C. Locals of the area are requested to continue their contributions to the Masjid as usual.
