CIRCULAR

Subject: Covid 19 – Proactive steps to minimize the spread of SARS Cov-2 and Influenza cases: Regarding.

Reference: Proceedings of 199th meeting of State Covid 19 Technical Advisory Committee, Dated: 23rd March 2023.

In view of a spike in Influenza cases & rise of Covid-19 cases in the past 2 weeks in the country and the state, following key recommendations are listed for early compliance and follow-up.

- The focus on 5-fold strategy of *Test-Track-Treat-Vaccination & Covid Appropriate Behavior (CAB)* should be continued.
- Laboratory Surveillance & testing of all Severe Acute Respiratory Illness (SARI) cases needs to be enhanced.
- Effective monitoring of IRI/SARI cases and testing for Influenza, SARS-CoV-2 and Adenovirus needs to be followed up.
- Availability of required *Drugs & Logistics* for Influenza & Covid-19 cases, across
 Healthcare facilities along with availability of *sufficient beds & human resources* needs
 to be ensured.
- Wearing of masks in hospital premises by patients, health professionals and health workers should be ensured by the concerned.
- Wearing of masks is highly recommended when senior citizens and those with comorbidities visit crowded areas including closed spaces and poorly ventilated places.
- Mock drills at Healthcare Facilities should be conducted at prescribed intervals to confirm the functional status of equipments and to ensure readiness for all exigencies.
 Separate instructions in this regard shall be issued.
- The exercise of whole genome sequencing (WGS) for tracking of newer variants should be expedited to evoke timely response. The suitable samples should be sent i. BMCRI, ii. NIMHANS and iii. NCBS.

The State / District Health Authorities and BBMP Health Authorities need to ensure that the above mentioned points are complied with and monitored in the larger interest of Public Health.
